This year's sale offers five options for candy selection. Each candy bar that sells for \$1.00 will be .25 profit for your unit. Your unit will be able to choose the type of candy bars for your members. Please be aware that in order to return a case of candy, the seal on the case cannot be broken.

Units will still have the option of ordering variety packs individual cases of one-of-a-kind candy bars. The range of choices will allow your unit to design the sale that best fits your youth sales team and the customers in your area. Additional amounts of candy will be available throughout the sale, in order to provide needed product on a timely basis.

The \$1.00 (1.5 oz.) candy bars will be available in the variety pack, consisting of 80 caramel, 48 krunch, 24 almond and 8 dark, totaling 160 bars in a case. Inside the case, the bars are packaged in 4 boxes of 40 bars. The one-of-a-kind cases (almond, caramel, dark chocolate or krunch) are made up of 72 bars per case, organized into 2 boxes of 36 bars.

All returns are due no later than 3/30/12.** Remember that additional candy supplies will be available in Champaign, Danville, and Watseka.
